Candidacy Timeline/General Policies:

- Completed applications must be received by the Office of Student Life (second floor of the ULV bookstore) by Monday, March 10th at 12 noon.
- Candidates for elected offices must each complete the materials (For example: if you are running with someone on a ticket for either President or Vice President - both candidates need to complete the application individually).
- Prospective candidates must be in good academic standing (current cumulative GPA of 2.5 or above) at the University and not on academic or social probation.
- Prospective and elected candidates must maintain a 2.5 semester and cumulative GPA throughout their elected term of office beginning Spring 2008. Grade Point Averages will be verified each subsequent semester while in office.

- All prospective candidates must attend 1 of 2 mandatory candidate meetings on either Wednesday, March 5th at 2pm or Thursday, March 6th at 10pm in the President's Dining Room. Failure to attend this meeting will result in your automatic removal from the ASULV ballot. (Please allow approximately 1 hour for this meeting).
- Candidates will be able to begin campaigning on Monday, March 24th at 8am. Campaigning includes but is not limited to meeting with constituency groups, posting promotional flyers and posters, and coordinating campaign related marketing on campus. All materials for campaigning (inclusive flyers and posters) must be removed on Friday, April 4th by 4pm. For specific rules and regulations regarding campaigning during ASULV elections consult the ASULV Constitution and Bylaws (copies may be obtained from the Office of Student Life or online at www.ulv.edu/asulv).
- ASULV Elections will take place on: Monday, April 7th and Tuesday, April 8th from 10am-2pm and 5pm-7pm at Davenport Dining Hall, Leo's Den, and in front of the Sports Pavilion and Wednesday, April 9th from 10am-2pm at Davenport Dining Hall, Leo's Den, and in front of the Sports Pavilion.
- Winners will be announced at Leo's Den on Wednesday, April 10th at 3pm.
- ASULV Meetings for the 2008-2009 school year are on Mondays from 3:00-4:00pm.
