*** Asterisk:** The following courses must be completed to be eligible to take comprehensive exams.

The current policy of limiting a number of transfer units to six(6) unit maximum has been waived. It has been replaced with a requirement of 50% of the degree coursework to be completed through the University of La Verne.

In the case of the Master's of Counseling 50% equals 16.50 semester units (of the 33 total) that must be taken through the University of La Verne. Students must have been enrolled in the last two years (2003-2004; 2002-2003).

Personal Psychotherapy: The department believes that students entering the counseling professional benefit professionally, personally and academically from experiencing personal psychotherapy, and believes that psychotherapy is a necessary training experience for counseling professionals.

Therefore, after admission, all students enrolled in the MS Counseling program are required to complete at least 20 hours of personal psychotherapy over a six month period or longer a in order to complete the program with a psychotherapist not affiliated with the university.
