The Campus Activities Board (CAB) at the University of La Verne is a non-profit student organization, which serves as the largest student program board on campus coordinating a variety of programs annually. The Campus Activities Board is one of the most exciting and active groups on campus. Consisting of nine committees that program in different areas of interest, CAB constantly strives to develop new and innovative programs for the ULV community. Committees include: Comedy, Concerts, Films, Games and Recreation, Intramural Sports/Spirit, Major Events (Homecoming, Winter Formal and Commuter Days), Multicultural Programs, Philanthropy and Special Events. Through involvement, CAB also provides students with concrete experiences in planning, publicizing, and implementing programs helping them develop lifelong skills to complement their academic experiences at the University of La Verne.

The Campus Activities Board is primarily funded by the Associated Students of the University of La Verne from student fees paid by each student enrolled at the University of La Verne.
