## Applying Takes Two Forms!

**Undergraduate students** must submit . . .

- 1) a verified Cal Grant Grade Point Average – GPA (form or electronically) to the California Student Aid Commission, *and*
- 2) fill out and submit a 2008-2009 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) to the federal processor.

**Students new to ULV as of this winter term:** Complete a FAFSA and get your GPA Verification Form certified by your previous school of attendance.

**Continuing ULV students (completed fewer than 24 semester college units, 36 quarters units, or the equivalent):** Complete a FAFSA and get your GPA Verification Form certified by your high school (include senior year coursework).

**Continuing ULV students (completed a minimum of 24 semester college units, 36 quarters units, or the equivalent):** Complete a FAFSA. ULV will submit your GPA Verification electronically to CSAC by the March 2<sup>nd</sup> deadline.

**Continuing ULV students who have a Cal Grant:** Complete a FAFSA. You do not need to complete a GPA Verification Form to renew your award. ULV will certify your Cal Grant renewal eligibility by the March 2<sup>nd</sup> deadline.
